

調選之「三個考慮」、「七個原則」 Principles for Reprioritising of Programme Choices

六月放榜，是否大勢已定？

當然不是，你還有一次調配機會，同學千萬不要放過。

甚麼人會積極調選呢？有三種人：一為有新發現的同學，他們像哥倫布，最近才知道讀醫科要有化學，因為他們沒有選化學，因此惟有調選；二為突然頓悟的同學，他們像達摩祖師，忽然發覺原來自己有讀文學的天份，因此要將文學放在Band A；三為受偶像影響的同學，他們的偶像包括師兄或朋友，他們見到師兄因選讀法律而平步青雲，因此照跟無誤！

若要調配，請同學留意以下數項考慮：

- 一、**有需要才調配**，不要人調你又調，以為不調會吃虧，有時候一動不如一靜。
- 二、**興趣**：影響你的取向最大的始終是興趣，仔細考慮你真正喜歡甚麼課程，不要受其他因素影響。
- 三、**客觀條件**：所謂客觀條件，是指課程的要求，例如你想報讀精算，院校去年的要求是數學A及另一科A，你手上有2A這個成績嗎？沒有又何必將精算放在前三位呢？

除了以上三個基本考慮，還要留意以下幾個調選原則：

- 一、**重要科失手放後**：報讀醫科的重要科目為化學、選修工程之重要科目為數學及物理，如果你發覺重要科目考得一敗塗地，請將該些課程的選報次序調後一些，把頗感興趣而相關重要科目成績理想的課程放在Band A可增加成功機會。
- 二、**重要科得手放前**：如果你化學考得好，你不妨把醫科放在Band A第一選擇，因為派位除了計算成績外，還要考慮個人選報優先次序。
- 三、**把已經參加口試的課程放在第一位**：原因簡單，因為口試那個分數可能在遴選時給你助力，使你順利被取錄，至少你比那些沒有參加口試的同學優勝！
- 四、在部分院校(例如：港大)若將以下課程填A會被優先考慮：**社會科學、文科、商業管理及建築。**
- 五、**了解難入科目**如精算、醫學、土木工程、建築、法律、財務、藥劑、牙醫等，如成績稍遜便不要亂選。
- 六、**了解一些比較易入的科目**如純理科、神學、宗教、機械工程，如成績稍遜而有興趣讀則不妨考慮。
- 七、如果你考取的成績不理想，**記得將副學士或高級文憑課程放前少少**，該些課程可能是你的唯一希望！

請多運用以上「三個考慮」及「七個原則」來調選課程。

祝各位得心應手，入讀理想院系的心儀課程！

Students have the opportunity of reprioritising their programme choices under JUPAS after the announcement of the HKALE results. In doing so, you should take note of the following -

- Reprioritise your choices only when it is necessary. Do not make any changes simply because others do so. It may be better for you to maintain your original choices.
- Interest should be the most important factor affecting your choice. Think carefully which programmes you really like without being affected by other factors.
- Can you meet the admission standards of the programmes you desire? If not, why put them at the top of the list?
- If you have scored poorly in subjects that are crucial for admission to certain programmes, rank those programmes as lower priorities.
- If you have done well in certain key subjects for a particular programme, you may consider putting it as your first choice in Band A.
- You are advised to choose a programme for which you have attended an interview as your first choice because interview performance may give you an edge over other applicants.
- Certain institutions (e.g. HKU) give priority to students who have chosen the following programmes in Band A: Social Sciences, Arts, Business Administration and Architecture.
- Find out the programmes that are difficult to gain admission to. Do not choose them if your examination results are not very outstanding.
- Find out the programmes that are relatively easy to gain admission to. Consider choosing these programmes if you do not have very good results but have some interest in them.
- If your examination results are less than satisfactory, you should list associate degree programmes and higher diploma programmes as higher priorities.

May you be admitted to the programme you desire!
